

Rate Structure

Below is the rate structure for facility use at Rock Eagle.

Lodging

\$250.00 (per night) for traditional cottage. \$410.00 (per night) for new cottage. Each cottage will accommodate 22 people. All cottages have air-conditioned bedrooms.

Conference Fees

This fee includes use of meeting space, audio video equipment, set ups, pools, recreational spaces, etc. All groups except environmental education must pay the conference fee.
