

## 2019 Teen Leadership Summit Adult Leader Application Criteria

Thank you for your interest in volunteering as an Adult Leader at the 2018 Teen Leadership Summit(s). We do not want to discourage anyone from applying; however we want to make everyone aware of the conditions of each summit. Please read below for criteria concerning adult leaders.

### Joint, Classic, Adventure, and Beach Summits

All Summits are centered on leadership, outdoor adventure and environmental education; if you are an “inside” person, this volunteer role is not for you. For your job as an Adult Leader, you must be available 24/7 during the camp and willing to do the following:

- Be part of the “airport” team: meeting teens at the airport on the first day of camp and taking teens to the airport on the last day of camp
- Supervise teens in your assigned cabin
- Classic and Adventure volunteers need to participate in all activities – white water rafting, high ropes, hiking, swimming, etc. ...
- Beach Summit volunteers should be comfortable with the ocean, boats, hiking, and swimming
- Be willing to perform night duty in the middle of the night
- Paid camp staff will teach outdoor education classes and oversee high adventure activities. However, Adult Leaders are asked to lead small mentoring sessions, manners workshops, flag raising/lowering, and supervise on buses during travel to/from activities.
- Oversee kitchen duty, night recreation, sports activities, and much, much more!

## Application Process

We encourage military members to have supervisor's/commander's support and approval to apply as an Adult Leader. We support commander's decisions to have military members attend in a variety of statuses. We allow military members, retired military, non-military members, spouses, etc. to volunteer. Georgia 4-H covers airfare, lodging and meal expenses. Travel to and from the closest major airport is your responsibility.

For each Summit you will be required to arrive one day prior to the beginning of the Summit. This gives everyone time to settle in at the camp, meet other leaders and staff, and attend the mandatory adult leader training.

Applications are available to Interested adults (ages 21+). Adults should complete all forms with a wet or digital signature to be considered. Forms can be submitted with Adobe Reader, scanned & e-mailed to [milcamps@uga.edu](mailto:milcamps@uga.edu), or FAXED to 706-542-4373. All adult leaders will be subject to a background check.

The Georgia 4-H Military team will send an email with a tentative acceptance packet that will include transportation details for the volunteer and will confirm the camp(s) the volunteer will attend. Applications are all tentative until HR has approved the volunteer. Volunteers who participated in a 2018 camp may only need to fill out this form (2019 Teen Leadership Summit Adult Leader Application) unless notified that a new background check is required.
