**Awesome Aquatic Culture (4/1)**

Campers will dive deep into the wet world of Rock Eagle Lake. This day will be full of exploring via canoe, wading into the water to catch critters, and learning about the important role that water plays in our every day lives!



**Weather Wonders (4/2)**
