Support will be awarded for the 2022-2023 school year and is based on first-come, first-served basis for eligible applicants in the four counties (Chatham, Effingham, Twiggs, Washington) until all of the available funds have been used. The expected range of awards is \$500-\$1,000 per school. The goal is to impact as many students as possible, and to allow opportunities for economically disadvantaged students to attend. Schools awarded support will have the money applied directly to the total due the Burton 4-H Center resulting in a smaller amount owing from the school.
