• PURPOSE:

- Military connected youth in your community will become thriving, healthy, and successful emerging adults who are competent, resilient, ready for life, work, and relationships.
- Military connected youth in your community will become contributing and engaging citizens who will develop and sustain positive relationships with peers, community members, family members, and colleagues.

RESULTS:

- Military connected youth will gain knowledge and coping skills in the areas of Personal Understanding, Developing Mastery, and Growing Connections.
- Military connected youth will increase life skills needed for 21st century career development, e.g. problem solving, decision making, communication, leadership.

• SUGGESTED ACTIVITIES:

- Create and deliver opportunities for family engagement, youth leadership and civic engagement, skill and capacity building, cultural immersion and exchanges, and 4-H club experiences for military connected youth.
- Plan and actively participate in fundraising activities on behalf of 4-H Military Programs on the county level.
- Educate the community on the specific needs of military families, youth and children.
- Build an awareness of resources available for military families through cooperative extension.

• MEASURES:

- Number of new military youths who enroll in 4-H programs / military youths who enroll in a 4-H program that is new to them
- Self-reports of military connected youth and their parent(s) and/or guardian(s) on changes in behavior and/or practices after participation in a 4-H Military Programs opportunity.
