

# State 4-H Congress Dress Code

<u>State 4-H Congress is a professional affair</u>. 4-H'ers should be dressed neatly and appropriately at all times. Clothes should be in good condition without frays or holes. Undergarments must be worn, but not seen. Pajama bottoms are not considered pants and should not be worn outside of hotel guest rooms. Midriffs should not be exposed. No one's clothing should be a distraction to others participating in the event.

Specific guidelines include:

## **Opening Assembly (Tuesday)**

Better school clothes. Slacks, collared shirts, dresses, and pant suits. No shorts, jeans or t-shirts. Tennis shoes are not appropriate. Scholarship recipients should dress professionally.

## Leadership Banquet (Tuesday evening)

Better Sunday dress with coat and tie for gentlemen and dresses for ladies. State Officer elect will wear officer dress uniform.

## Presentations and Portfolio Interviews (Wednesday)

Coat & tie, dresses and pant suits or appropriate demonstration apparel.

## Free Time (Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday)

Collared shirts tucked in, shorts and belts for free time activities. T-shirts and short shorts are not appropriate.

Bring a swimsuit if you wish to swim in the hotel pool. Swimwear should be conservative and in good taste. Appropriate swimwear includes tankini's or one piece suits for ladies and swim trunks for gentlemen. A cover up must be worn to and from the pool.

## Night at Six Flags (Wednesday)

State Congress t-shirts with shorts. State officers may wear officer shirts. No short shorts.

### Celebration Banquet and Donor Tours (Thursday morning)

Come dressed to the Celebration Breakfast for your tour. Check your tour location for appropriate dress. Some will require professional dress. Others will require professional casual dress. Shorts, t-shirts, and tennis shoes are not appropriate for tours. In either option, be sure that your appearance showcases the best of Georgia 4-H.

### **Donor Reception and Annual Banquet (Thursday evening)**

Dressier dresses for ladies. Many girls will wear formal dresses. Coat and tie for men.

## Night Recreation (Thursday)

Shirts with shorts or blue jeans. No short shorts. Shoes must be worn.

### Winners Meeting (Friday morning)

Casual dress. Pajamas, short shorts, etc. are not appropriate.
