2. Chair 2: Both the terms “red” and “liver” are variations of what basic coat color of horses?

A: chestnut (not sorrel) E Sci 41

3. Chair 3: Name the two body types recognized by the American Miniature Horse Association.

A: Arabian type and Quarter horse type HHH 154-1

4. Chair 4: How many toes did the Eohippus have on the front limbs?

A: 4 E Sci 11

5. Chair 1: Will the average heart rate of a foal be higher or lower than the average for a mature horse?

A: higher E Sci 155

6. Chair 2: What B vitamin is usually supplemented in many feeds to help insure quality hoof growth?

A: biotin E Sci 128

7. Chair 3: Mares are known to be more actively cycling in heat during what type of daylength? Long or short?

A: Long Day breeders HHH 910-8

8. Chair 4: In what part of the horse’s vertebrae are the atlas and axis found?

A: cervical E Sci 203
