

- **2022 Contest Information**
 - May 20th
 - Check-in begins at 2:00 PM with the contest beginning promptly at 3:00 PM
 - Entries
 - Due through State 4-H Office in “Event Registration”
 - Closes at noon on Wednesday, March 30th, 2022
 - Each team (Junior and Senior) must provide one scorekeeper
- **Team Guidelines**
 - A county may have the following teams:
 - 2 senior teams
 - Each county may enter two senior teams. A senior team will be comprised of four members and a coach. With a four member senior team, they can also have two alternates entered. Teams of fewer than four (minimum of three) members may compete but will do so at a disadvantage in the written portion of the contest.
 - 2 junior teams
 - Each county may enter two junior teams. A junior team will be comprised of a minimum of four members and a coach. With a four member junior team, they can also have two alternates entered.
- **National Contest**
 - The winning county of the State Quiz Bowl Contest - Senior Division will be invited to participate in the National Contest
 - National Contest will be held in November at the North American Livestock Exhibition in Louisville, KY.
 - Partial expenses paid by GA Dairy Youth Foundation and Milk Check-off.
- **Contest Guidelines**
 - Senior teams will take a written test comprised of 50 questions
 - Each round will consist of two teams
 - 5 team questions and 20 toss up (Senior Division)
 - 5 team questions and 15 toss up (Junior Division)
 - Contest will be double elimination
- **Submitting Written Questions**
 - Writing contest questions is a good way to practice. Additionally, this allows the opportunity to possibly hear a question you submitted. Current dairy industry news, events, policies, procedures and statistics are most likely to be selected for contest inclusion.
 - 25 written questions should be submitted by e-mail to Dr. Jillian Bohlen at jfain@uga.edu no later than May 6th, 2022
