



VENDORS & ADDITIONAL COSTS

2024-2025 ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS

Vendor Payments: UGA requires groups to pay the vendor(s) directly for their Environmental Education Program with the exception of dissection supplies (billed in final Burton 4-H invoice). A W-9 and Sales Tax Exemption Form(s) are also required for vendors. Groups unable to provide these forms will be subject to 7% Georgia sales tax from the vendor. Groups are responsible for notifying vendors of actual attendance numbers and minimums. Contact the vendor for additional waviers, deposits, and/or invoices required for reservation.

Environmental Education Requests: Notify your Environmental Education Coordinator via email of any planned program that requires additional supplies, costs, and/or reservations to be made by the Burton 4-H Center. After the reservation has been made and verfiried by the vendor, the group will receive reservation details and acquire responsibility of reservation. Please note: supplies and availability are not guaranteed and vendors may take reservations up to 12 months in advance. Groups are required to provide transportation to the vendor location (charter bus, vans, etc.)

School Led Requests: For Sunday arrivals, school led evenings, and/or a group interested in a program after departing Burton 4-H Center, please contact vendors directly to make a reservation.
