 - Due to the State 4-H Office through Georgia 4-H Event Registration
 - Opens Thursday, March 25, 2021 and closes Friday, May 7, 2021 (contest entry deadline)
- Coach/Scorekeeper meeting on Wednesday, May 12 at 10:00 AM via Zoom

Team Guidelines:

- A county may have the following teams:
 - 2 senior teams
 - Each county may enter two senior teams. A senior team will be comprised of four members and a coach. With a four member senior team, they can also have two alternates entered. Teams of fewer than four (minimum of three) members may compete but will do so at a disadvantage in the written portion of the contest.
 - 2 junior teams
 - Each county may enter two junior teams. A junior team will be comprised of a minimum of four members and a coach. With a four member junior team, they can also have two alternates entered.

National Contest

- The winning county of the State Dairy Quiz Bowl Contest-Senior Division will be invited to participate in the National Contest
- The National Contest will be held in November at the North American Livestock Exhibition in Louisville, Kentucky
- Partial expenses will be paid by Georgia Dairy Youth Foundation and Milk Check-Off

Contest Guidelines:

- Senior teams will take a written test comprised of 50 questions
 - This test will be open to be completed via Qualtrics on Monday, May 10-Tuesday, May 11
- Each round will consist of two teams
 - 5 team questions and 20 toss up (Senior Division)
 - 5 team questions and 15 toss up (Junior Division)
- Contest will be double elimination



Submitting Written Questions

- Writing contest questions is a good way for teams to practice. Additionally, this allows the opportunity to possibly hear a question your team submitted. Current diary industry news, events, policies, procedures, and statistics are most likely to be selected for contest inclusion.
