- 2. All Georgia state rules apply.
- 3. Heifers must be owned, in the possession of and under the daily care of the exhibitor by November 1, 2020.
- 4. An original registration certificate is required on all registered heifers and must be presented at check in. All registered heifers must be in the name of the exhibitor.
- The show committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes as necessary. 5.
- 6. Health papers are required & all entries must have a legible tattoo or tag number.
- 7. Check in will be from 4-7 PM on January 29th and from 6-8 AM on January 30th. All commercial heifers will be weighed on Saturday morning, January 30th from 6-8 AM.
- 8. All cattle must be properly halter broken and lead in a manageable fashion.
- 9. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless they have more than one per class. Any substitute must be cleared with show management. A current 4-H or FFA member may show the second animal. Exhibitors can show no more than three heifers.
- 10. Each exhibitor must furnish their own feed, feed pan, water bucket and be responsible for the care of the animal while on the show grounds.
- 11. The show is not responsible for loss or damage to any livestock or equipment.
- 12. Heifer Information:
 - a. Registered heifers will be shown by birthdate.
 - b. Commercial beef heifers and commercial dairy heifers will be shown by weight.
 - c. There must be at least 5 heifers of one breed to constitute a breed class.
 - d. All others will be placed in other breeds class.
- 13. Premium Information:
 - a. Showmanship
 - i. Classes will be divided by grade. The 1^{st} place showmen from $4^{th} 8^{th}$ grade will come back for Junior Showmanship Final Drive. The 1st place showmen from 9th-12th grade will come back for the Senior Showmanship Final Drive. The winner of each final drive will earn a belt buckle.
 - b. Registered/Weight Class
 - i. Class premiums, ribbons and awards will be given
