Introduction	Tell them the Facts: Share what you've learned! Give 3 main ideas with facts to support each.		
Body	Tell them what you told them: Briefly summarize what you told the group.		
Conclusion	Tell them what you are going to tell them: Use a story or catch phrase and introduce yourself.
