



Raptors Vocabulary

Adaptation: special behavioral or physical characteristics of an animal that help it

survive

Bioaccumulation: the build-up of toxins within a food chain often leading to negative

effects for the top predators

Habitat: the environment which an organism lives

Indicator Species: a species extremely sensitive to environmental changes; humans use

these species to detect if environmental problems are occurring

Molting: the process of replacing feathers

Nictitating a clear third eyelid used by some raptors for extra eye protection

Raptors: birds of prey that have sharp talons, a shredding beak, and usually

hunt their prey
