



Sensory Awareness Vocabulary

Adaptation: a behavioral or genetic alteration or response in an organism that

facilitates survival and reproduction in response to surroundings

Cones: parts of the retina that interpret color

Crepuscular: animals most active at twilight (dusk/dawn)

Diurnal: animals most active during daylight hours

Echolocation: reflected sound emitted from an animal (for example: bat/dolphin)

to locate objects

Nocturnal: creatures most active at night

Rods: parts of the retina that interpret shades of black and white

Triangulation: a system used by animals to interpret the source of a sound
