

Burton 4-H Center on Tybee Island Rules and Regulations

Acquaint your students with these rules and regulations before your trip and provide a copy to each chaperone. **All visiting chaperones are expected to enforce these rules.**

General Rules

1. Shoes must always be worn unless you are in your dorm or on the sand volleyball court. Flip-flop sandals are only for inside the dorms.
2. The (long) bell rings for classes and meals. The (short) bell rings for KP and canteen.
3. No running, climbing, or bouncing balls on A-frame.
4. No students allowed on the dock or forest trail without an adult.
5. No running on the gravel. Please walk with purpose.
6. Outside drinks and snacks are not allowed inside the dining hall during meal times.
7. Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. – 7 a.m. Students must be in dorms and quiet.

Class Time Rules:

1. Always listen to instructors and adults. "Give me 5", a raised hand indicates it is time to listen.
2. Get ready for class BEFORE the bell rings. This includes going to the bathroom, getting water, putting on the correct shoes, and appropriate clothing.
3. When the bell rings for class, go immediately to your group's meeting spot.
4. Student cell phones are not allowed in classes. Please have an assigned adult take photos.
5. For MARSH ECOLOGY class, closed toed shoes are required. The best options are rubber boots or old sneakers. You can alternatively visit the "Wall of Lost Soles."
6. For DISSECTION classes, closed toed shoes are required.
7. For SURF SLEUTH (seining) class, shoes are required to be worn in the water such as sneakers, water shoes, or sandals with a tight back strap. **Crocs or flip flops are not permitted.**
8. For BEACH classes, everyone must always wear shirts and shorts in the water. It is recommended to wear water resistant clothes or a swimming suit under your clothes.
9. For BEACH classes, there is no swimming at any time in any Burton 4-H Center class, participants should only be in the water ankle deep. The INSTRUCTORS are always the deepest person in the water.

Dorm Rules:

1. Students are responsible for cleaning dorms before departing. Chaperones shall supervise, instruct, and help with use of cleaning supplies. Cleaning instructions are located on the bulletin board inside the dorm. Cleaning supplies is found in the chaperone bathroom underneath the sink.
2. Dorms Inspections will be scheduled. and approved by a Burton 4-H Center staff member before the group departs.
3. Rinse off sand and mud outside the dorm at outside hoses and outdoor showers. Rinsing sand and mud off in dorm sinks and showers will lead to clogged drains.
4. Students are not allowed into the dorms without an adult. Student can only go into assigned dorm.
5. Students should not go behind dorms.
6. No food or drinks are allowed in the dorms. This prevents roaches, rats and raccoons.
7. Do not spraying bug repellent or sun block in dorms. Aerosols will glue sand to the floors.
8. Do not bring / leave money or valuable items in dorms. The Burton 4-H Center is NOT responsible for lost or stolen items.
