What to Bring/Packing List Georgia 4-H Cloverleaf Camp 2024 at Camp Jekyll

****All items (including clothing) should be marked with the camper's name with a waterproof marker. Do not bring jewelry or other items of value. Wheeled luggage is recommended****

Items to Bring:

- Waterproof sunscreen!
- Lip balm/Chapstick
- Linens, blankets or sleeping bag (Linens are NOT provided at camp)
- **Pillow**
- Daily change of clothes and underwear (shorts, tee shirts, etc. Pack clothes that can get dirty and sandy!) – See Clothing Guidelines below for more information
- If you can find out from your County Agent which color crew you have been assigned, you are encouraged to bring clothing (bandanas, socks, hats, lays, shirts) in the color you have been assigned to show your crew spirit during Pirate Games (our version of field day fun!)
- Shoes and Socks (bring at least 2 pairs—one that can get wet and muddy) and/or sports sandals with a heel strap (flip-flops only allowed in cabins; crocs worn with heel strap allowed)
- Towels (wash cloth, shower towels and beach/pool towels)
- Soap, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant (not aerosol) and other toiletries
- **Shower shoes** for wearing in bathroom and showers
- Bathing Suit – please make sure these are one-piece or tankini suits that are modest and appropriate
- Rain jacket
- Sunglasses and Hat/cap/visor
- Money for canteen/gift shop, sweet shop, and Historic District and Jekyll Village shops
- Plastic garbage bag for wet clothes
- Insect Repellent (roll-on or lotion repellent recommended)
- Money for lunch for bus trip to and from camp as needed. Please contact your county office for this information.
- Day Pack

Optional Items:

- Camera, film (use of disposables is recommended, mark your full name on camera!); campers may not always be able access to cell phones for activities for picture taking
- **Flip Flops** will be allowed only in cabins
- Pen, paper, stamps
- Large sealable bags for collecting sea shells
- Water Bottle (campers will be issued a small 20oz plastic water bottle but encouraged to bring an insulated spare)

DO NOT BRING:

- Knives
- Radios, handheld video games, tablets, etc
- Shaving cream
- Fireworks
- Chewing gum
- Fishing Equipment
- Excessive amount of cash or items of great value (emotional or monetary)
- Flashlights (there is a beach lighting ordinance on Jekyll because of nesting sea turtles) and flashlights can be distracting in cabins at night

Clothing Guidelines:

- No clothing should be worn that violates the Code of Conduct.
- Underwear should be worn at all times and should not be visible.
- Camp is rough on clothes – bring only clothes that are okay to get wet or muddy.
- Bring extra socks and underwear – you always need them!
- No two-piece bathing suits – one-piece or tankini suits that are modest and appropriate

4-H Statement: Personal Items of Value and Cell Phones:

4-H'ers are to leave radios, computers, electronic devices, fit bits, valuable watches, and video games at home unless authorized by and used under direct supervision of the member's leader. 4-H'ers are discouraged from bringing cell phones to camp and events. 4-H'ers should not use cell phones after lights out. No programs are to be disturbed or interrupted by use of personal electronic equipment. 4-H'ers are not allowed to bring skates, roller blades, bicycles, laser lights or other personal items that would make safety an issue. 4-H'ers are discouraged from bringing excessive amounts of money to 4-H events. Georgia 4-H and the 4-H Centers assume no responsibility for lost, stolen or damaged items of value including cell phones or money that are brought to 4-H activities.

Georgia 4-H at Camp Jekyll does not recommend bringing any electronic equipment. These devices are often lost or destroyed by the harsh coastal environment (water, salt, and sand). Camp Jekyll takes no responsibility for these items.
