# Charades

## Materials

- species cards
- bucket or container

## Instructions

This is a group game where each participant will take turns acting out a wildlife species. The facilitator will put the species cards in a bucket or container. One participant will draw a card. The player must then act out that animal. They can use gestures, facial expressions, and body movements to convey the meaning. No verbal communication is allowed. Once the species is correctly guessed, another participant will play.

*Remember that not all species apply to Junior competitors.*
