- The barn will be open on Friday, July 30, 2021.
- Lamb check-in is Saturday, July 31, 2021 from 7:30 until 9:00 a.m. Show Begins at 10:00 a.m.
- Goat check-in is Saturday, July 31, 2021 from 7:30 until 9:00 a.m. Show Begins approximately 15 minutes after the conclusion of the lamb show

RULES OF SHOWS

<u>General</u>

- The Show Committee has final decision making privileges over all show rules.
- Unless permission by the show committee is given, exhibitors must show his/her animals in all classes.
- The show is open to any current Georgia 4-H or FFA exhibitor.
- An official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (Health Certificate) with the individual animal identification number is
 required to show. An inspector with the State Department of Agriculture may be on site and current health papers must
 be available upon request.
- An exhibitor can show up to four lambs and/or four goats.
- Weight will determine market classes; there is no weight requirement.
- There will be no re-weighing once the animal has left the scale area.
- Shearing and/or clipping must be done outside of barn, weather permitting.
- Limited pen space is available on a first-come, first-served basis, and participants are encouraged to show off the trailer.
- The owner is responsible for the care and cleanup of his/her own animal(s).
- Shavings for bedding purposes are in the barn.
- For showmanship, exhibitors will be classified based on grade level as of September 1, 2021
- There will be no Pee-Wee or novice classes.
- All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Show Rules and Regulations will be followed.

Entry and Premiums

- Entry fee is \$20.00 per lamb and/or goat.
- Completed entry form with payment must be postmarked or hand delivered to Gordon County Extension/4-H no later than Friday, July 23, 2021. Any entry postmarked/received after July 23rd will be charged a \$20 late fee; no exceptions.
- Checks should be made payable to Gordon County 4-H
- Premiums earned during the show will be paid by check and mailed during the week following the show date.

Please keep in mind that entry fees are nonrefundable; no exceptions.

Lamb Show

• Entries must be wether and/or ewe lambs; no rams will be allowed.

Goat Show

• Entries must be wethers and/or does; no bucks will be allowed. Does and wethers will be shown separately if at least 40 of each sex are entered.

Special Rules and Regulations Due to COVID-19

PLEASE READ IN ENTIRETY

<u>All animals will be encouraged to show off the trailer. Generators are</u> <u>extremely encouraged.</u>

- If a registered exhibitor has a positive COVID-19 test, experiences COVID-19 symptoms, or is in quarantine after a direct contact with someone with COVID-19, the exhibitor and their immediate family <u>SHOULD NOT</u> come to the show. You may contact Tim Street at 706-629-8685 to request a refund or name a substitute showman for your animals. The substitute showman can be anyone registered as an exhibitor in the show, but needs to be identified prior to show time.
- We will follow UGA and Georgia 4-H COVID-19 related policies at that time, but current policy requires that all participants undergo a COVID-19 screening questionnaire from staff, and all spectators will be asked to self-screen.
- All youth and adults will be <u>REQUIRED</u> to wear masks at all times inside a UGA Facility and anytime where 6 foot social distancing cannot be maintained outside. You can bring your own mask or one will be provided for you.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the show area.
- If you or anyone in your party has experienced symptoms, been diagnosed with, or suspected to have COVID-19 within 14 days prior to the show, STAY HOME!
- If you experience symptoms of COVID-19 during the event, you will be isolated and asked to leave.
- Food and drinks will be on your own. Feel free to bring your own meals and snacks; 4-H will not be providing any food or drink items through a concession stand this year. No cooking on site and no shared meals.
