



## Environmental Education Day Program Suggested Packing List

You will find a general packing list below. Please adjust clothing as needed based on the season you are visiting and classes participating in. Label all items with student and school names. Only old clothes are needed; Pack and wear clothes that can get dirty, sandy, and muddy! New clothes may be ruined with heavy outdoor use. Please note that Burton 4-H Center is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

### ENCOURAGED ITEMS

- \* Sack Lunch
- \* Day pack, backpack, fanny pack
- \* Change of dry clothes
- \* Closed toe shoes (Required for salt marsh ecology or shark dissection)
- \* Water shoes / Sandals (ex: chacos, tevas, sandals with back strap)
- \* Combination of long sleeve/short sleeve t-shirts
- \* Combination of long pants/shorts
- \* Raincoat and/or rain gear
- \* Sweater/sweatshirt
- \* Jacket (including gloves, scarf, warm hat, etc. if cold)
- \* Hat/cap/visor
- \* Sunglasses
- \* Reusable water bottles
- \* Waterproof sunscreen
- \* Insect Repellent
- \* Lip balm/Chapstick
- \* Plastic garbage bag for wet clothes
- \* Hand sanitizer

### OPTIONAL ITEMS

- \* Reusable coffee mug (adults only)
- \* Camera
- \* Binoculars
- \* Money for Canteen/Gift Shop & Vending Machine – we ONLY accept cash or checks
- \* Pencil, paper for Journals
- \* Resealable bags for collecting seashells
- \* Rubber boots for salt marsh ecology – you may visit the “Wall of Lost Soles” to borrow a pair
- \* Fabric softener sheets (for gnats)
- \* Burton 4-H Journal Questions

### DO NOT BRING

- \* Flip-flops (not permitted in classes. Shoes are required to have a heel-strap. Crocs worn with heel strap are allowed but not during seining class)
- \* Cell phones (not permitted in classes)
- \* Candy, gum (not permitted in buildings)
- \* Knives/weapons of any kind
- \* Fishing equipment
- \* Fireworks
- \* Electronic equipment
