3rd Annual Dummy Roping Contest - Thursday, June 6

DIVISIONS:

Cloverleaf (Ages 9 thru the 6th grade)
Junior (7th & 8th graders)
Senior (9th thru 12th graders)
NEW THIS YEAR (Adult Division)



Open to all Georgia 4-H members! 4-H'ers will sign up at the event! No pre-registration required!

ROUND 1

- ✔ All contestants will get 3 attempts to rope the dummy.
- ✔ The contestant must stand behind a line on the ground while roping or they will be disqualified.
- ✔ The contestant must allow the loop to completely leave their hand before it touches the dummy.
- ✔ Contestants who rope all 3 move to ROUND 2. If there are no youth that catch all 3 times, then youth who catch 2 will move on. If there are no youth that catch 2, then youth who catch 1 will move on.

ROUND 2

- ✔ The dummy will be moved out. Each remaining contestant will get 1 more loop. Catches move to ROUND 3.

ROUND 3

- ✔ The dummy will be moved forward after each loop in a sudden death format until there is a winner.

PRIZES

- ✔ Winners of all 3 divisions (Cloverleaf, Junior & Senior) will receive custom trophy belt buckles from Molly's Custom Silver
- ✔ Winner of the Adult Division will receive a special award
