T-shirts will be made if we have 25 sign up for them. T-shirt design is attached T-shirt sizes should be entered on the google document when entering the rabbits. Cost of t-shirts is \$10. T-shirt proof is attached color of shirt will change.

T-shirt order must be in by 4 PM on Wednesday, November 27th. You do not have to have a rabbit to order shirt.

You will be able to enter 3 rabbits at a time on the google document. There is no limit to the number of entries. The rules are attached. The T-shirt proof is attached.

4-H members defined - An exhibitor must be in the 1st grade or older on September 1, 2018 and cannot have completed high school. The Champion of the State Rabbit Show will not be recognized at the Special Events Banquet at the Georgia 4-H State Congress and will not be recommended for Master 4-H Status.

2019 FFA/4-H Georgia State Rabbit Show Rules:

1. Show shall be governed by the latest rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association and filing of entries indicates acceptance of these rules. However, we have opened the show to non-recognized breeds and pets so that all FFA and 4-H members may exhibit their rabbits.

2. The show committee will not be held responsible for loss in case of fire, theft, accident, or providential destruction in the showroom. However, every precaution will be taken to insure a safe environment for the exhibitors and the animals.
3. The show committee reserves the right to substitute, or add judges if need be. Also, the show committee reserves the right to change the judging order or class description.
4. Any rabbit or cavy showing signs of disease will be removed from the showroom and entry fees forfeited.
5. Any exhibitor indicating ownership of rabbits and/or cavies being exhibited on the judging table, harassing, interfering, or attempting to influence a judge will be disqualified and will forfeit all fees and winnings.
6. All animals must be exhibited in their natural state. Cutting of hair, dyeing, or altering in any way is not permitted.
8. Youth may show in all youth shows. Youth breeds will be called to the table first, followed by the open breed. Youth will need to pay attention to the breed schedule.
9. No smoking will be allowed at any time in the showroom.
10. Any unauthorized changes will be considered a disqualification.
11. Show officials may make changes to show classes and descriptions to better accommodate entries and students.
