

Fannin County Young Farmers Association Breeding Ewe and Doe Holiday Classic December 5, 2020 10:00 a.m. Fannin County School System Ag Facility 43 Station Ridge Rd Blue Ridge,GA 30513 (on Google or Waze type in FCSS Ag Facility but the address is a little off on these apps. The ag center road(Station Ridge) is on the south side of the FC Fire Station(so turn left at the stop sign on Windy Ridge, follow this road down to the ag center)

- 1. This show is open to 4-H and FFA members through 12th grade in school plus pre-club age children in grades 1-4 as of September 1, 2020.
- 2. Animals must be owned by the exhibitor on or before November 16, 2020.
- 3. An entry form signed by the parent, agent/teacher and the exhibitor must be mailed with the correct fees postmarked by November 16, 2020. Entry fees are \$20.00 per animal and \$5.00 for showmanship. *Late entries fee will be charged an additional \$20.00 per exhibitor*

4. Shavings are \$5.00 per stall needed. Please indicate the number needed by adding the \$5.00 per stall to your entry form fee amount. You may bring your own shavings, please indicate "0" on the shavings needed line. Make checks payable to Fannin County Young Farmers. - 5. Each exhibitor may enter up to 5 commercial ewes, 5 purebred ewes, and 5 breeding does.
- 6. Commercial ewes and breeding ewes must be tagged with the official state ear tag on and before November 18. Purebred ewes must have an ear tag or tattoo. Original registration certificates must be presented at check-in.
- 7. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspections is required with the individual identification and the following statement: FLOCK OF ORIGIN IS FREE FROM FOOT ROT, SCABIES, CONTAGIOUS ECTHYMA (SOREMOUTH), CUTANEOUS FUNGAL LESIONS, SCRAPIE, And/or ANY OTHER INFECTIOUS DISEASE. Any visible sick animal will be asked to leave the premises.
- 8. All must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear. Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.
- 9. Showmanship is open to all exhibitors. Showmanship will be broken down by grade in school. Classes will be combined based on numbers in each grade.
- 10. Commercial ewes and does will be shown by weight. Purebred ewes will be shown by birthdate.
- 11. Showing off the trailer will not be allowed, all animals will be assigned a pen by show staff.
- 12. Exhibitors must show their own animals unless they have more than 1 per class. Any substitute must be cleared by show management. A current 4-H or FFA member entered in the show may show the second animal.
- 13. Each exhibitor must furnish their own feed, feed trough, water pail and be responsible for their animal while at the show.
- 14. The show nor the Fannin County School System will not be responsible for loss or damage to any exhibit, but will give the best care and attention to prevent loss or damage to any exhibitor.
- 15. Does and ewes can be checked in on Friday from 4:00 pm till 8:00 pm or from 7:00 am -9:00 am Saturday. The barn will be locked and secured at 9:00pm Friday night.
- 16. Premiums will be based on entries.
- 17. Concessions will be available for both breakfast and lunch.
- 18. Shavings are \$5.00 per stall, please indicate on the entry form how many stalls you need by entering the bags of shavings you are paying for.


