Diamondback Terrapin (DBT's) Safety on Tybee Island

What is a Diamondback Terrapin (DBT)?

- 🍀 DBT stands for Diamondback Terrapins
- These are a species of semi-aquatic turtle native to coastal tidal salt marshes from the Gulf Coast stretching all the way up to Maine.
- BBT's habitat is in salt marsh or brackish water marshes. Brackish water is a mixture of salt and freshwater.
- BBT's common name refers to the "diamond" pattern on top of its shell (carapace). DBT colors and patterns vary from geographic locations and individual species.

DBT Safety Concerns on Tybee

- BBT's vary in conservation status from threatened to endangered based on state and currently have no federal protection.
- 🏶 Georgia and several other states list Diamondback Terrapin as threatened or "of special concern".
- 🍀 Diamondback Terrapin face several conservation issues.

What does the theme mean?

- The theme means that there are on-going safety issues our Tybee Island terrapins and other coastal terrapins face, and we need YOUR help to raise awareness for these salt marsh turtles.

- Have you ever been stuck somewhere? Did someone help you out?

Student Journal Cover Art Contest Rules and Guidelines

- 1. All students in grades K-12th are eligible to participate.
- 2. Individuals may only submit one entry.
- 3. Individuals must be the creator of the entry.
- 4. Art will only be accepted by hand-drawn medias. Examples of accepted medias include: colored pencil, paint, crayon, marker, etc.
- 5. No digital art or collages will be accepted.

- 7. The filenames of Burton 4-H Journal Art Contest submissions must include the individual's first name, last name, school, and grade.
- 8. Participants must include a 10-30 second video on why **#SafetyforDBTs** is important! - **9.** Youth <u>are required</u> use the Burton 4-H official Qualtrics entry form; any entries received without using the official entry form will be disqualified.
- 10. Any entries received after the deadline of Thursday, April 22nd, 2021, at 11:59 pm will be disqualified.
