Hart County Invitational Sheep Show

Show Location: Hart County Agriscience Center 1951 Bowman Hwy Hartwell, GA 30643

- 1. The show is open to Georgia 4-H and FFA members.
- 2. All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Rules and Regulations will be followed. The only exception is there is NO limit to entries.
- 3. Only wethers and ewes allowed. NO RAMS. All sheep will be shown as market. Wethers and ewes will be shown together.
- 4. Sheep will be weighed and divided into classes as evenly as possible. After the sheep leave the scales, there will be no re-weighs.
- 5. Classes: Exhibitors must show their own sheep in classes. If the exhibitor has more than one sheep in a class, he/she can find an exhibitor substitute to show for him/her. The substitute exhibitor must to be entered in the show as well. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
- 6. Showmanship: Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show (weight class) and owned by the exhibitor. There will be a pee-wee class for any exhibitor under first grade (prizes awarded).
- 7. All sheep must be tagged with a scrapie tag.
- 8. Entry Fee: The entry per animal is \$20. The postmark deadline is July 20, 2020. NO LATE ENTRIES OR DAY OF SHOW ENTRIES! Showmanship entry fee is \$5.00 per exhibitor. Money will be used for prizes and/or prize money after expenses are removed. The amount of prize money is based on entries.
- 9. Pens will be preassigned according to the total number of entries. Showing off trailers will not be allowed.
- 10. A certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with the individual identification and the following statement: Flock of origin is free from Foot Rot, Scabies, Contagious Ecthyma (soremouth), Cutaneous Fungal Lesions, Scrapie or any other Infectious disease. All ewes must have a USDA approved scrapie tag in their ears. Registration numbers will not serve as the scrapie tag for the show.
- 11. The Hart County FFA reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Hart County FFA are final.
- 12. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
- 13. There are no weight limits.

- 15. The Ag Center will open at 10 AM on Friday morning. Weigh-in will be 1-3pm, with the show starting at 5pm. Showmanship will be first (youngest to oldest) followed by weight classes.
- 16. The Hart County FFA accepts no responsibility nor assumes any risk for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the "Hart County Invitational Sheep Show."
