

## Johnson Co. Swine Shootout Market Hog Show





All entries must be postmarked by January 17, 2020

Registration Fee: \$30.00 per pig Showmanship Fee: \$10



- 1. Pens are limited and will be assigned first come, first serve. Pigs may be shown off the trailer and all trailers must be set up in the designated trailer area.
- 2. Pigs will be penned 2 per pen. Bring your own dividers.
- 3. No pens will be allowed to be used for tack.
- 4. All pigs must have an official health certificate.
- 5. Each exhibitor may enter 3 animals.
- 6. All pigs must have a readable ear tag.
- 7. Entries will be limited to 150 head.
- 8. Divisions will be determined the day of the show. Animals will be classified when brought to scales.
- 9. Classes will be split based on weight. Classes will be broken with as many even number of entries as possible. Hogs will be shown lightest to heaviest.
- 10. There is no minimum weight for hogs, maximum weight is 280 lbs.
- 11. Barrows and gilts will be shown together.
- 12. The judge's decision is final in all classes.
- 13. No clipping of pigs at the show.
- 14. There will be no re-weighs after the pig leaves the weigh in area.
- 15. Payout will be determined upon number of entries.
- 16. Showmanship classes will be determined by entries. Show is open to all students ages 4-21.
- 17. The Johnson County FFA Chapters and the Johnson County School System, its members, nor anyone or anybody associated with the show are not liable for accidents, injuries or theft.
- 18. Exhibitors are responsible for his or her own animal and property. All exhibitors assume all risk associated with this.
- 19. The barn will open on Saturday, February 3rd at 7:00am
- 20. Weigh-in will be from 7:00am-9:00am on February 1st. The show will begin at 11:00am on February 1st.
- 21. Pigs will need to be dropped at the barn and trucks/trailers will then be parked in the designated areas.

The Johnson County Middle School FFA will have a concession stand open for lunch.
