- Applicants must currently be showing or have shown one of the following species: Cattle, Swine, Lamb, Goats, Dairy Cattle or Horses here at the Georgia National Fairgrounds
- Must be able to attend the *mandatory* Leadership Training *April 12-13, 2019* here at the Georgia National Fairgrounds
- We reserve the right to review any and all social media accounts throughout their year of service.
- Each elected ambassador along with a parent/guardian will be required to sign a code of conduct/contract before their year of service

Each applicant will need to complete the attached questions and submit a 2 minute video explaining why you would be a great livestock ambassador for the Georgia National Fairgrounds.
