

## Tybee Lighthouse Vocabulary

| <b>Daymark:</b>        | An identifier marker visible to mariners as a navigation guide in day light. The unique color scheme and/or pattern that identifies a specific lighthouse during daylight hours |
| <b>Fresnel Lens:</b>   | A lens made of circular rings to help project light up to 20 miles; normally used in lighthouses to help guide ships  |
| <b>Keeper:</b>         | A person who manages or looks after the light and lighthouse grounds  |
| <b>Lighthouse:</b>     | A tower containing a beacon light to help guide ships at sea  |
| <b>Summer Kitchen:</b> | A separate kitchen detached from the main house. Usually used when the weather was hot so the the stove would not heat the whole house  |
