

Matching Game

Materials

 1 set of cards per group - species with photos, food sources, or vocabulary

Instructions

Facilitators will divide participants into smaller working groups (3-4 participants recommended). Each group will get 1 set of cards. The cards will be shuffled, and groups will match the cards – either the name of the species with the animal's image of the word (food source or vocabulary) with its definition. Groups work together to match all their cards. This could be a timed activity, rewarding the first group to complete the task accurately.

Remember that not all species apply to Junior competitors. Depending on participants' skill levels, you may use a smaller sample of the food source or vocabulary cards.
