Memory Game

Materials

- 1 set of cards per group – species with photos, food sources, or vocabulary

Instructions

Facilitators will divide participants into smaller working groups (3-4 participants recommended). Each group will get 1 set of cards. The cards will be shuffled and put into rows, face down. Each person will turn over any two cards, hoping to match the name of the species with the animal's image or the word or the food source/vocabulary word with its definition. If the cards match, the participant removes them from the playing area and is awarded one point. If the cards don't match, they are returned face down to their location. Play continues until all the cards are successfully matched.

Remember that not all species apply to Junior competitors. Depending on participants' skill levels, you may use a smaller sample of the food source or vocabulary cards.
