

## **Commercial Dairy Heifer Show Clinics**

\*Please note there is a \$10.00 fee per exhibiter or animal if showing more than 1\*

Morgan County Extension will conduct two clinics for the commercial dairy heifer program exhibitors to educate about dairy heifer nutrition, health, and showmanship. Any Georgia 4-H or FFA member showing a commercial dairy heifer is welcome to attend with their animal(s).

During the first clinic on **December 14th, 2019**, we will deworm, body condition score, vaccinate, weigh and dehorn (if needed) heifers as well as conduct a basic halter breaking/showmanship clinic.

During the second clinic on **Saturday, January 11th, 2020,** we will progress to more advanced showmanship, trim feet and body condition score heifers again. Please note that heifers **DO NOT** have to be WELL halter broken to attend—this is a learning experience!
