RULES

- 3. Be sure to fill out info on the left.
- 4. Deadline to submit completed MY4-H PASSPORT online or hard copy is April 20th, 2020 to be considered for prizes.
- 5. Must submit passport to Morgan Co. 4-H Office.

2020 June Dairy Month 4-H Poster Contest Details

Who can participate?

Only youth 4th—12th grade, are eligible for state prizes. Any Morgan County youth ages 5 to 18 are eligible for the MY4-H PASSPORT prizes.

Learn more about milk and milk products and their importance to human health by creating a fun poster! The theme of the poster is "*The Art of Dairy"*!

RULES for Poster

1. Poster must be on standard poster board and must be of uniform size - <u>14" X 22" (half a poster board)</u> - other sizes are ineligible. *Posters are available at the 4-H office but a parent must call to schedule outside pickup.*

2. Follow the theme.

- 3. Newspaper, film cartoon characters and other copyrighted characters may **not** be used.
- 4. Posters should contain only original, hand-drawn artwork done by the participant. Computer-generated artwork and text are not acceptable and will result in disqualification of the poster.
- 5. **Do not attach items thicker** than the poster board to the poster.
- Get ideas from television, magazines, parents, and friends. Be creative! Study pictures from your grocery store, a nearby dairy, the Dairy Alliance website (<u>http://thedairyalliance.com</u>), the National Dairy Council (<u>https://www.nationaldairycouncil.org</u>), or milk cooperatives for additional ideas.
- 7. Keep it simple and to the point.
- 10. Your county 4-H will then submit a photo of your poster to the state for judging if grade eligible.

Scoring Guidelines

Originality – attracts attention, holds interest 40%	
Follows theme 20%	
Conveys message – easily understood, well- done design 15%	
General appearance – well planned, good design; easy to read; neat; no spelling errors 15%	,
Accurate information – factual 10%




