

Nightwalk & Duskwalk Vocabulary

Beach:	A shore of a body of water covered by sand, gravel, or larger rock fragments
Bioluminescence:	Light emitted from an organism
Constellation:	A group of stars forming a pattern usually named after its form or a mythological figure
Crepuscular:	Occurring or active at dawn and dusk
Diurnal:	Occurring or active at daytime
Echolocation:	The location of objects by reflecting sound, in particular that used by animals such as dolphins and bats
Nocturnal:	Occurring or active at night
Plankton:	Floater or drifter; Organisms floating in the sea or fresh bodies of water unable to swim against a current
Planet:	Celestial body moving in an elliptical orbit around a star
Sense:	How the body interprets or experiences one's surroundings. Humans have 5 senses- sight, touch, taste, smell, and hearing
Star:	A celestial body of hot gases that radiates energy
