

Question Card Swap

Materials

question cards assembled

Instructions

To assemble the question cards for this game, the cards should be printed single-sided and cut out. Put the question card on top of the corresponding answer card. Use tape to secure the cards together so that someone can read the question and then 'flip open' to determine the answer.

Distribute one question/answer card set to each participant. They will walk around the room and find a partner. The first person will read their question. The second person will answer the question. The first person will tell the second person if they are correct or incorrect. Then, the process repeats - where the second person will read the question and the first person answers.

Once both partners have read and answered questions, they switch cards. Participants continue moving around the room, partnering with other participants and asking/answering questions.

This works particularly well for larger groups but could be challenging for smaller groups.

Remember that not all species apply to Junior competitors.
