Entry Deadline: Entries must be **POSTMARKED** and **PAYMENT** made on or before **November 2nd, 2024**. ****All entries are non-refundable****

1. Show is open to all FFA & 4-H members ages 9 to the 12th grade.
2. Exhibitors are responsible for their own animal and assume all risk. The Stephens County FFA Alumni or anyone associated with the show will not be liable for any accidents, injury or theft
3. Health papers will be required per state rules.
4. Original registration papers must be presented for all registered heifers.
5. Registered heifers will be shown by breed and birthdate. In order to qualify as a breed show, there must be 6 heifers of that breed entered in the show. Those with less than 6 will have the choice to show in all other breeds (AOB) or Commercial.
6. **NEW** – Percentage/composite breeds (Simmental, Shorthorn, ect) will show with the purebred classes.
7. Commercial heifers will be shown by weight.
8. Steers will be shown by weight.
9. The show order for showmanship and classes will be determined after all entries are received.
10. **NEW** – No animals may be brought in on Friday – Tack only but at your own risk.
11. The Judge's decision will be final.
12. Tie spaces may be limited so entries will be accepted in the order they are received.
