

Sea Star Dissection Vocabulary

Benthic: Bottom dweller or living on the seafloor

Broadcast Spawning: A form of reproduction where eggs and sperm are

spewed into the surrounding environment of the

ocean

Detritivore: An animal that feeds on dead organic material,

especially detritus

Echinoderm: A marine invertebrate phylum which includes sea

stars, sea urchins, or sea cucumbers

Fragmentation: The process by which sea stars reproduce through

regeneration of broken limbs

Keystone Species: A species which other species largely depends on.

If it were removed the ecosystem would change

drastically.

Penta-Radial Symmetry: Arrangement of body parts around a central axis.

Can be split into five equal parts (penta)

Regeneration: Formation of new animal or plant tissue

Wasting Syndrome: A disease of unknown causes that is responsible

for the mass mortality of sea stars

Water Vascular System: A network of water vessels in the body used by

echinoderms for locomotion, food and waste

transportation, and respiration
