- 1. The show is open to 4-H and FFA members, including pre-club members, 6 years old and up.
- 2. All Georgia 4-H and FFA livestock rules and regulations will be followed.
 - o Exception is, there are no limits on number of head you can show.
- 3. Only Does will be allowed to show and will be shown as commercial, by weight.
- 4. Animals will be weighed and divided into classes by show officials. After the animal leaves the scale there will be no re-weighs.
- 5. **Classes:** Exhibitor must show their own animal in class. If an exhibitor has more than one animal in class they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared before entering the ring.
- 6. **GA Bred & Born Class/Show:** There will be a separate weight class/show for Georgia Breed and Born Does. All of the same rules apply for this separate weight class. There is an unlimited amount of entries for this show and each exhibitor must show their own animal in this class. If an exhibitor has more than one animal entered in this class they can have another exhibitor show for them. There will be a \$10.00 entry fee per goat that is enter for the weight class. All money received will be put towards the payout afterwards after expenses.
- 7. **Showmanship:** Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship class. The animal must be entered in the class and owned by the exhibitor. There will be a \$5.00 charge for showmanship. All money received will be paid out after expenses. Premiums will be determined by number of entries.
- 8. This show will allow bracing.
- 9. All goats must be tagged with State Identification tags. A certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with individual identification. All does must have USDA approved scrapie tag in the ear. Registration numbers will not serve as scrapie tags for this show.
- 10. Entry Fee: The entry fee per animal is \$25.00. If entries are postmarked after January 10th, 2020, late fee of a one-time additional \$20.00 must be mailed with payment. If late fees are not mailed with payment they will be charged and collected at check-in of a one-time additional \$20.00 if received after January 10th, 2020. Entries after deadline are not guaranteed a shirt.
 - Payouts will be:
 Top 5 individuals in weight classes, along with Grand and Reserve in weight.

 Showmanship prize will be awarded a Belt Buckle for Champion Showman and prize for Top 5 in each division.
- 11. Due to limited space, pens will be assigned on a first come first serve basis. (The show committee reserves the right to ask you to house your animals on your trailer, if you are able, if we run out of pen space.) Unapproved pen alterations are not allowed. There will be a minimum of 2 goats per pen.
- 12. The show committee reserves the right to review and change the rules if deemed necessary. All decisions made by the show committee and Judge are final.
- 13. Absolutely **no refunds** will be given.
- 14. There are no weight limits.
- 15. Weigh in will be Saturday, February 1st, 7:30am to 8:30am. The barn will open Saturday, the 10th at 6:30 am. The show will start at 9:30am. Other accommodations can be discussed with show staff.
- 16. The show committee or facility accepts no responsibility nor assumes any risk for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the Small Town Show Down.
