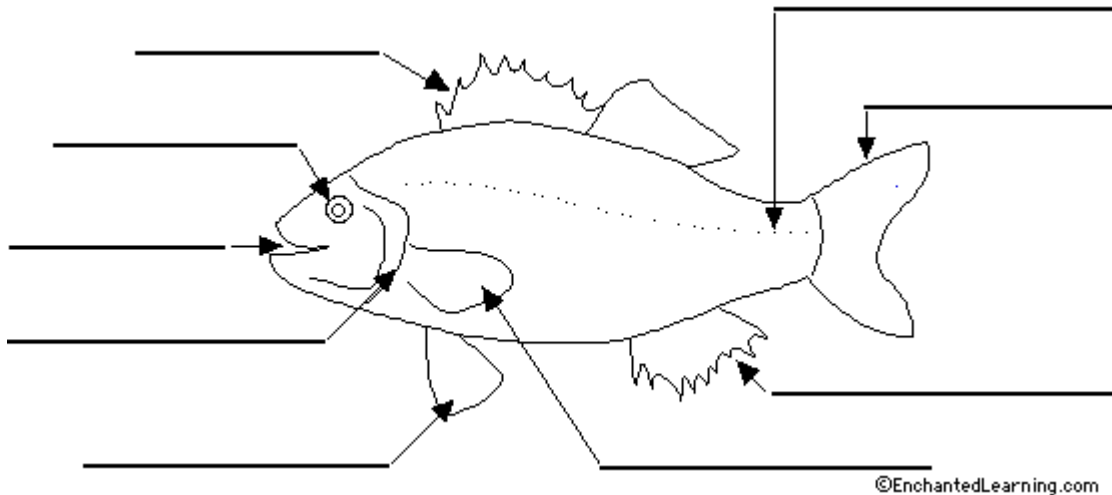


Surf Sleuth (Seine Nets) Journal Questions
