Market Lamb Rules

1. The show is open to 4-H and FFA members from all states. Any person **Pre-Club (Age 3+) - 12th Grade** (*There will be no Pee-Wee showmanship due to a lower age limit on entering show.*) Only wethers and ewes allowed. NO RAMS. All animals will be shown as market animals and slick shorn.
2. Only exhibitors, Judge and show personnel are allowed in ring. ***If student cannot show animal by their self do not enter them.***
3. Animals will be classified as ***Black Faced, Natural Colored, White faced/Speckled, and Hair sheep***. Each classification is guaranteed to make a minimum of 1 class if there is an entry. Class winners will compete for Top 3 Individual awards.
4. Lambs will be weighed and divided into classes by show officials. After the lambs leaves the scales there will be no re-weighs.
5. Enter as many lambs as you wish. There is no limit to # of animals you may enter.
6. Classes: Exhibitors must show their own lamb in class and/or championship drive. If the exhibitor has more than 1 lamb in class/championship drive they can have another ***exhibitor*** show for them. (*Substitute show person must have entry in the show. Violations will result in disqualification!*)
7. Showmanship: Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show and owned by the exhibitor. Showmanship classes will be determined by the number and ages of exhibitors entered.
8. All lambs must be ear tagged with the identification number entered on the entry form **AND** have a scrapie tag. (scrapie tag can be used as entry tag). Entry tag does not have to be an official state tag.
9. **Entry Fee: The entry per animal is \$30.** Late entries will result in an additional \$15 late fee.

10. **PAYOUT:** Money will be used for prize money after expenses are removed. Top 10 in each class will receive a payout. Amount of prize money is based on entries. Showmanship will be split in a manner that results in a minimum of 10 per class due to payout schedules.
NEW Top 2 placing individuals from each showmanship class will come back to compete for a belt buckle for their division. Divisions will be broken as follows:
4th grade and below; 5th-8th grade; 9-12th grade.
11. Limited space and pens are available. Pens are available on a first come basis. **EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN BEDDING!** Exhibitors have the right to choose to show off of their trailers if they choose. Please provide your own power source if you choose this option.
12. Lambs must have milk teeth. We recommend that show lambs be born after Jan. 1, 2016. Lambs showing evidence of any of their permanent incisors will not be allowed to show.
13. A certificate of Veterinary Inspection is required with the individual identification and the following statement: **Flock of origin is free from Foot Rot, Scabies, Contagious Ecthyma (soremouth), Cutaneous Fungal Lesions, Scrapie or any other Infectious disease.**
14. The Last Chance Show Committee reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Show Committee are final.
15. Exhibitors have the freedom to show the style of their choice.
16. Absolutely no refunds will be given.
17. There are no weight limits.

Goat Rules

1. The show is open to 4-H and FFA members from all states. Any person **Pre-Club (age 3+) - 12th Grade** (*There will be no Pee-Wee showmanship due to a lower age limit on entering show.*) No Pee-Wee showmanship due to lower age on entries. Only wethers and does allowed. NO BUCKS. All animals will be shown as market animals and slick shorn.
2. Does and wethers will be shown separately. A top 5 for each gender will be awarded.
3. Goats will be weighed and divided into classes by show officials. After the goat leaves the scales there will be no re-weighs.
4. Enter as many goats as you wish. There is no limit to number of animals you may enter.
5. Classes: Exhibitors must show their own goat in class and/or championship drive. If the exhibitor has more than 1 goat in class/championship drive they can have another **exhibitor** show for them. (*Substitute show person must have entry in the show. **Violations will result in disqualification!***)
6. Showmanship: Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show and owned by the exhibitor. Showmanship classes will be determined by the number and ages of exhibitors entered. *TOP 2 placing individuals from each showmanship class will come back to compete for a Belt Buckle and placing for their division. Divisions will be broken as follows: 4th grade and below; 5th-8th grade; 9th-12th grade.*
7. All goats must be dehorned or have horns tipped.
8. All goats must be ear tagged with the identification number entered on the entry form **AND** have a scrapie tag. Scrapie tag can be used as entry tag. Tag entered does not have to be an official state tag.
9. **Entry Fee: The entry per animal is \$30.** Late entries will result in an additional \$15 late fee.
10. **Payout:** Money will be used for prize money after expenses are removed. Top 10 in each class will receive a payout. Amount of prize money is based on entries. Showmanship will be split in a manner that results in a minimum of 10 per class due to payout schedules.
11. Limited space and pens are available. Pens are available on a first come basis. **EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR OWN BEDDING!** Exhibitors have the right to show off of their trailers if they choose. Please provide your own power source if you choose this option.
