General Rules:

1. The contest will consist of three divisions.
 - a. Swine: 5-8 classes
 - b. Sheep and Goats: 5-8 classes
 - c. Cattle: 5-8 classes

*Questions classes will be announced at the beginning of each round, if needed.
2. 10 minutes will be provided for each class.
3. Junior and Senior Divisions will consist of a maximum of four (4) individuals per team with the top three (3) scores constituting the team score.
4. All decisions of the Southeastern Three contest will be considered final.
5. The Southeastern Three officials reserve the right to make changes deemed to be in the best interest of the contest.
6. The Southeastern Three committee nor the Georgia National Fairgrounds will be responsible for any accidents or injuries at the contest.
7. The Southeastern Three committee nor the Georgia National Fairgrounds will be responsible for any lost or stolen personal items or damages to property.
8. Official dress is not required.
9. Communication devices of any kind will not be permitted during the contest.

Age Divisions

1. The Southeastern Three is open to anyone up to the age of 19 (as of 9/1/20) and has not completed high school from any state.
 - a. Junior Division: Middle School and younger (8th grade and younger)
 - b. Senior Division: High School students (9th-12th grade) that are younger than 19 as of September 1st of the current year.
2. There is no minimum age for the Southeastern Three contest; however, contestants must be able to go through the contest on their own merit.
3. Junior Division aged participants will be permitted to judge in the Senior Division if they wish.

Awards Divisions

1. Individual and team awards will be presented in the following categories in both the Junior and Senior Division:
 - a. Cattle
 - b. Swine
 - c. Sheep and Goats
 - d. Overall

COVID-19 Protocols

Below are the protocols and actions we will take to provide the safest environment possible for participants during the SE3 Livestock Judging Contest.

- Masks will be worn by all in attendance at all times.
- All registration will be completed online. No onsite registration will be allowed.
- Check in will only be for coaches to pick up the team's scantrons. Check in line will be socially distanced with marks indicating acceptable places to wait.
- Sutherland Arena (indoor) and Practice Ring 3 (outdoor) will be utilized to optimize social distancing.
- Livestock pens are 140' (30'x 40') in perimeter allowing for 23 participants at each class based on 6-foot social distancing guidelines.
- Marks will indicate where students will be allowed to stand for each class.
- There will be a total of 5 (or more) classes in each round with a total of 3 rounds during the day.
- No food will be served.
- Awards will be virtual Saturday, December 12 to prevent all participants being in close contact at one time.
- Sanitizing stations will be available at each class.
- No market lamb or market goat classes in a stanchion will be present. Also, there will be no handling of animals by the participants.
- Livestock Arena Dimensions
 - Sutherland Arena: 59, 157 square feet; 250' x 125' show arena with dirt floor on top of clay base; 874 stadium seats
 - Practice Ring 3: 44,000 square feet; 110'x 220' show arena
- We will be sure to have the announcer remind participants to sanitize frequently.
