UGA Sigma Alpha Swine Show

- 1. Show will be held Jackson County Agricultural Facility located at 1869 County Farm Road, Jefferson GA 30549.
- 2. The Show is open to current 4-H and FFA members only.
- 3. Entries must not exceed **285 lbs.**
- 4. All Georgia 4-H and FFA State Livestock Rules and Regulations will be followed.
- 5. Only Market Gilts or Barrows Allowed, there will be no breeding gilt classes. All animals will be shown by weight.
- 6. An exhibitor can bring up to 3 hogs and no more than 3.
- 7. Weigh-In: After the Hog leaves the scales there will be no additional weigh in without show official consent.

Weigh in will be Saturday, January 30th from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.

- 8. Hogs will be weighed and divided into classes of eight to twelve (8-12) Hogs per class as equal in number as possible. (Number of classes may vary depending on the number of entries and the show official's discretion).
- 9. **Classes:** Exhibitors must show their own hog in class. If the exhibitor has more than one hog in a class, they can have another exhibitor show for them. This must be cleared with show officials before showing.
- 10. The show will be split into a gilt show and barrow show as long as there are enough animals registered. (provided 15 of each sex)
- 11. **Showmanship**: Each exhibitor must show their own animal in showmanship. The animal must be entered in the show and owned by the exhibitor. (Showmanship will begin at 9:30 a.m.) There is a \$5.00 fee for showmanship participation.
- 12. Pens will be assigned to counties (The show committee reserves the right to ask you to house your animal on your trailer if we run out of pen space.) Pen Alterations are not allowed. You may be asked to pen pigs two to a pen. Bedding will be provided, but if any extra is needed it will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- 13. All market swine must be blood tested **PRV and Brucellosis negative** and have an official health certificate. Any visibly sick animal will be asked to leave the premises.
- 14. All hogs must have a premise ID tag and state identification tag.
- 15. **Entry Fee**: The entry fee per animal is \$20. Late entries fee will be charged an additional \$20.00 per exhibitor.
- 16. UGA Sigma Alpha reserves the right to review the rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the UGA Sigma Alpha are final.
- 17. No alcoholic beverages or weapons on school premises are allowed any violators will be asked to leave immediately.
- 18. UGA Sigma Alpha, UGA, or any associated agency or any of its affiliates do not accept responsibility nor assume any risks for injury to the exhibitor or animal due to or resulting from participation in the UGA Sigma Alpha Swine Show.
- 19. Social distancing/ face covering guidelines will follow UGA Extension guidelines on January 30th. These guidelines will be provided via email to the email provided on the entry form.
