# What Am I?

## Materials

- 1 set of cards per group – using the cards with both the species name and image are recommended, especially if this is an ice-breaker activity where students may not be as familiar with the content yet
- masking or painter's tape

## Instructions

Each participant will have 1 card taped on their back. They should not know what their card says. Participants will walk around and ask other participants yes/no questions to guess their card. For example, “am I an animal that flies?” or “could I be a food source for an owl?” They will continue to ask questions until they successfully guess their card.

*Remember that not all species apply to Junior competitors.*
